Established in the year 1996, Navy Children School, Port Blair is an **esteemed institution** that stands tall amongst all the other schools in the Islands.

The **vision of the school** is to empower, innovative, develop creative minds, provide goal oriented training, inculcate discipline, to inspire, empower, nurture, be technologically advanced and vocationally equipped to finally achieve desired successful results.

The school houses a total of 1158 students out of which 583 students are from the primary and 575 are from the secondary.

- c) It makes me feel immensely proud and happy to announce that, NCS has retained its title as the “**Best senior secondary school**” in the urban category and **Overall Best Senior Secondary School** in the **Andaman and Nicobar Islands**.

4. Winning the **Inter-NCS quiz** conducted by NCS Mumbai, placing prizes in the Inter-NCS Declamation competition conducted by NCS Port Blair and Story Telling Competition conducted by NCS Goa, have been other proud achievements to name a few.

5. Winners of the **SHORT REEL** making competition conducted by the **AIDS Control Society**, which was appreciated at the **NATIONAL LEVEL** . **The Health Minister of India** interacted with the students of NCS, Port Blair.

Further, various online workshops to develop soft skills, Health and Hygiene, stress management during Covid, career counselling etc. were conducted for honing their skills.
